The Georgia Poultry Federation endorses the recommendations of the Special Council on Tax Reform and Fairness for Georgians. The Federation is a trade association which represents poultry growers, poultry companies and allied industry in Georgia, the nation's leading poultry producing state.

We appreciate the manner in which the Special Council approached the monumental charge to study Georgia's tax structure and make recommendations for reform to the legislature. The process was open and transparent as promised, and the Federation is thankful for the opportunity provided to all businesses and citizens of Georgia to be heard.

Throughout the process, the primary message from the Federation was that the Special Council's recommendations should acknowledge that Georgia businesses are in competition with other states as well as other nations throughout the world.
