
Enough is Enough!

Adult Smokers in Georgia Already Pay an Estimated \$1.038 Billion Per Year in Cigarette Taxes Alone!



This graphic estimates the total annual state and federal government revenues paid by adult smokers in Georgia.¹ These are current revenues and do not include the proposed \$1.00 increase in the state excise tax. Total government revenues are an estimated **\$1.038 Billion!**
